Notice to Applicant:

1. Exceptional Circumstances (EC) provisions aim to assist large families; households that produce nappies or domestic medical waste. Eligible households may apply for free fortnightly kerbside collection of one additional 140L EC waste bin (in addition to the one 140L general waste bin fortnightly collection provided as part of your Council waste service charges). In addition, eligible households with special medical needs may apply for free fortnightly kerbside collection of one additional 240L EC Recycling bin (in addition to the one 240L recycling waste bin collected fortnightly provided as part of your Council waste service charges).
2. You may be require to provide documentation (such as driver's licence, passport or Medicare card) to prove your identity as part of this application.
3. If you do not renew your Exceptional Circumstances additional waste collection service you acknowledge you are no longer entitled to the additional waste service and Council will remove the additional bin service.
4. This is a renewal only and any change of circumstances need to be submitted in person to Kangaroo Island Council, Customer Service, Kingscote or Penneshaw Community Business Centre.
5. Applications for this service are required to be submitted annually (on a financial year basis).
6. Additional bins granted under Exceptional Circumstances are required to display an 'Exceptional Circumstances' sticker in the appropriate colour for the current financial year. EC waste bin will have a green body and blue lid. EC recycling bin will have a yellow body and yellow lid.
7. Exceptional Circumstance bins will not be collected over part of the peak summer school holiday period as well as the week before and after Easter (2 week period). During this time, red lidded general waste bins will be collected weekly.
8. The Fleurieu Regional Waste Authority (FRWA) may conduct bin audits on Exceptional Circumstance bin service households.
9. FRWA reserves the right to cease a collection service where there is a repeated misuse of the service. This includes removal of the Exceptional Circumstances bin(s) if it is found that the conditions under which it was approved are false or have changed and the application does not comply with conditions.
- 10 Applicants need to advise Council when/if they become ineligible for the Exceptional Circumstances bin(s). When this occurs, the Exceptional Circumstances bin(s) will be emptied on the next available collection day and will be removed by FRWA on that day.
