TIMBER STOCKYARD AND FACILITY CONSULTATION



Council's proposed lease to T-Ports Pty Ltd for Timber Stockyard and Processing Facility, Ten Trees Lagoon Road Kingscote, is now open for Public Consultation for a period of 21 days starting Thursday 27 January 2022 and closing at 5:00pm, Thursday 17 February 2022.

Council is seeking written submissions with respect to the leasing of local government land as follows:

LAND: Ten Trees Lagoon Road (corner North Coast Road), Kingscote SA 5223 (CT5611/656, piece 5, Filed Plan 103561 in the area named Kingscote, Hundred of Menzies) known as "Kangaroo Island Resource Recovery Centre."

PROPOSED USE OF AND ASSOCIATED WITH THE LAND: Establishment and operation of a stockyard and processing facility for stock piling timber and producing woodchips.

Associated with the facility will be the movement of materials to the Kingscote Wharf via semi-trailers, A-Doubles or B-Doubles.
