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Support Dauncey Street - Go Local First

Council has teamed up with Dauncey Street traders to encourage patronage of small businesses between Commercial and Murray Streets. The "Go Local First" campaign kicks off on Friday, 25 November 2022 for the month of December 2022.

"Council has worked with traders on the campaign to support all small businesses across Kangaroo Island in the lead-up toward Christmas," said Kangaroo Island Mayor Michael Pengilly. "The campaign's purpose is to create a multiplier effect for shoppers so that every dollar spent in small businesses goes back into the local economy," Mr Pengilly said.

"We welcome all traders on the affected section of Dauncey Street to be involved and participate," he said.

Mayor Pengilly said Council is most aware of the disruption to Dauncey Street over the past several months.

"Council has made provisions for parking without penalty, including parking behind the Kingscote Town Hall in an effort to help traders," Mr Pengilly said.

Mayor Pengilly also said the new public toilet in the car park behind the Kingscote Town Hall is now open to the public.

"The safety tape around the toilet will be removed when new handrails are installed, but the facility is now open to the public," he said.

The Go Local First campaign is made up of three key components:

1. In-store discounts/vouchers
