Plaques & Memorials in Columbarium

To place a plaque or headstone within Council's Cemeteries, an Interment Right is to be issued and paid in full.

Plaques & Plinths

Bronze plaque set upon cement plinth 381mm (w) x 279mm (h)

Columbarium and Memorial walls 145mm (w) x 127mm (h)

Plagues & Plinths are ordered through Council.

Standard size headstones

Monuments or headstones are to be arranged by families through Monumental Works of their choice but must fit within Council regulations.

The Cemetery Authority shall not be responsible for the upkeep, maintenance, repair or replacement of any memorial (eg. Plague, monument or structure)

The Cemetery Authority may act to remove any structure that has become unsafe, dilapidated or unsightly in its opinion.



Council Cemeteries

Kangaroo Island Council has care and control of five Cemeteries on KI. Three Cemeteries are currently operational, being American River, Kingscote and Penneshaw and two Historical being Emu Bay and Pioneer—Reeves Point. The Cemeteries are open daily throughout the year from dawn to dusk.

Kingscote

330 Bullock Track Kingscote.

Burial allotments:

Penneshaw Cemetery is a listed place of State Heritage significance, which is under Council's care and control

Burials are permitted without approval from Heritage SA. Prior to all works within this Cemetery (erection of headstone, plaques urns etc.) a Development application must be submitted through Council and forwarded to Heritage SA (DEWNR) for approval

Development Applications are only required for the Core Heritage Areas: A and B. A referral to State Heritage fee will apply.



Emu Bay (Historical)

Lot 457 Wallaby Run Emu Bay. Historical Cemetery only, there are no records of those buried.



Cemetery Information

Interment Right (Lease)

Interment Right is issued for a burial or interment of ashes for a period of 99 years. These can be preleased or issued on advice of death. Kangaroo Island Council will grant a license for the exclusive right of burial or interment in the next designated space within the cemetery.

At the end of Interment Right period, if family members do not renew, the plot can be reused.

Relinquishment of an Interment Right must be in writing to Council.

Burials

All arrangements for burials are made through a Funeral Director of the family's choice. The Funeral Directors must liaise with Kangaroo Island Council before determining a burial date as at least three working days notice is required.

Interment of Ashes in Columbarium

Interment of ashes in the columbarium is arranged directly between a family member and the Kangaroo Island Council.

Landscaping

It is not permitted to plant on memorials within the Cemetery grounds. No ornaments, floral or other tributes are to be place on or in the lawn areas outside of the approved plinth of headstone as they cause hindrance to maintenance operations.
