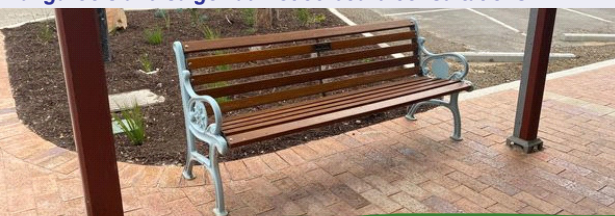


## MEMORIAL POLICY

## FIRE PREVENTION - 105F NOTICES

Private landholders are responsible under the *Fire and Emergency Services Act 2005* (the Act) for preparing their properties before the start of the Fire Danger Season.

Under the Act, if a property is not fire ready by **1 December 2022** for fire danger season, Council's Fire Prevention Officers will serve a 105F notice accompanied by a fine of **\$473**.

Landholders then have 21 days to complete the required works after receiving a 105F notice. If after 21 days the required works have not been done, Council will engage a contractor to complete the necessary works with the **cost applied to the property owner and charged against the land**.
