FIRE PREVENTION - 105F NOTICES

Private landholders are responsible under the Fire and Emergency Services Act 2005 (the Act) for preparing their properties before the start of the Fire Danger Season.

Under the Act, if a property is not fire ready by 1 December 2022 for fire danger season, Council's Fire Prevention Officers will serve a 105F notice accompanied by a fine of \$473.

Landholders then have 21 days to complete the required works after receiving a 105F notice. If after 21 days the required works have not been done, Council will engage a contractor to complete the necessary works with the cost applied to the property owner and charged against the land
