From this week until mid-December, Council will be re-sheeting South Coast Road between Elsegood and Woods Roads with funding from the SA Department of Infrastructure and Transport (DIT) Upgrade of Local Unsealed Roads on Kangaroo Island Program.

- West Road to Vietches Road
- Vietches Road to Starrs Road
- Starrs Road to Elsegood Road
