Our Field Officers are currently responding to a high volume of vandalism and theft across the Island. Items being removed or damaged include roadside furniture, public barbeques, camp grounds, road signs and roadwork signs.

This activity effects road safety but also costs ratepayer money to repair and replace these items. Money that could otherwise be spent improving roads and other amenities across the Island.
