FRWA KERBSIDE COLLECTION 2021

Fortnightly collection of all 3 bin types resumes from Monday 1 February 2021 for all of Kangaroo Island.

Remember your first collection on this week may be Recycle (yellow lid) bin only, this affects:

- Parndana, Emu Bay and Cygnet River on Tuesday 2 February 2021
- Penneshaw and D'Estrees Bay on Friday 5 February 2021

The first collection of Exceptional Circumstances (EC) bins (blue lid) in 2021 will occur with first fortnightly collection of general waste on or after Monday 1 February 2021. Head to the Fleurieu Regional Waste Authority website www.frwa.com.au to confirm the kerbside bin collection schedule by street name.

Additionally the Kangaroo Island Resource Recovery Centre (KIRRC) is open 7 days a week from 9:00am to 4:30pm.

How can I check what goes in WHICH BIN?

Your 2020-2021 kerbside calendar has 3 pages which outlines what can go in each bin and is a ready reckoner for disposal of everyday household items.
