Subsequent quarterly payments will be due on 17 December 2021, 17 March 2022 and 17 June 2022.

COVID VACCINATION CLINIC

Book now for your last chance to get vaccinated on the Island! All Kangaroo Island residents aged 12 and over are now eligible.

Last date for first dose Pfizer (ages 12-59) is 18 September.
Last date for first dose AstraZeneca is 2 October.

First dose AstraZeneca is available for anyone aged 18 and over. If aged 18-59, consent must be provided subject to discussion with the vaccine provider and understanding of the risks and benefits.

Appointments for those aged 12 to 15 (without complex medical conditions) must be made via the booking number. A parent, guardian or caregiver must be present at the appointment as part of the consent process.

Advance bookings are recommended however, walk-in appointments are accepted for Pfizer (13-18 September) or AstraZeneca (20 September to 2 October).

FIGHT THE BITE: MOZZIE PROTECTION

Have you noticed the abundance of mosquitoes hanging around already this year? We have put together some handy tips to help you evade the nasty pests coming into the warmer months.



- 1. Cover-Up:** Loose comfortable clothing (long sleeves & trousers)
- 2. Apply Repellent** – containing DEET (diethyltoluamide) or picaridin
- 3. Clean Up** – Don't provide breeding sites. Remove items that can hold water. This includes poorly maintained rainwater tanks and gutters.
