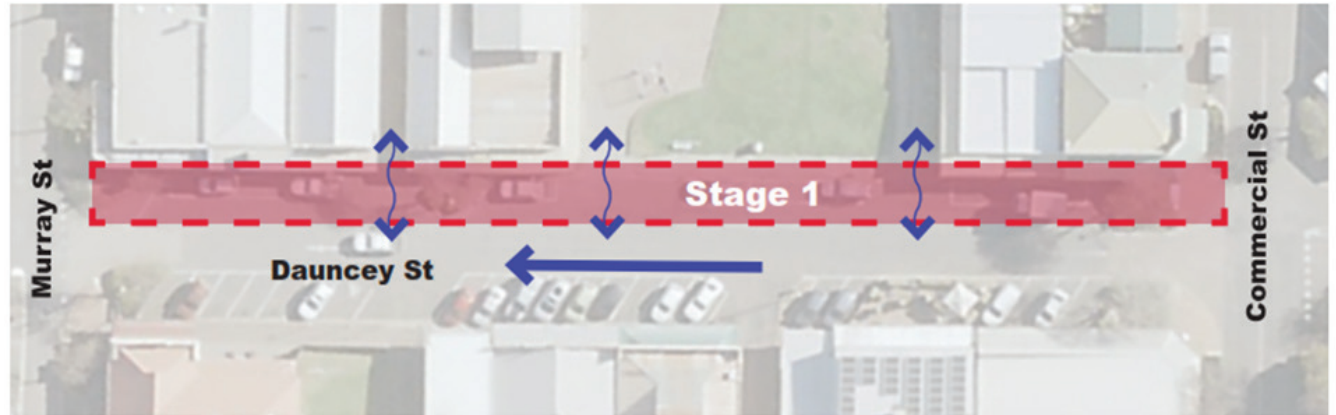


TOWN CENTRES UPGRADES: UPDATE 10 to 17 MARCH 2022

CONSTRUCTION WORKS

Stage one of construction works on the north side of Dauncey Street will continue next week. Work will include the demolition of the existing pavement and kerbing in preparation for new edging, paving, footpath and tree planting. These works have been scheduled in consultation with business owners to minimise disruption.



SUPPORT LOCAL BUSINESSES

Please note that businesses on Dauncey Street will be open during regular trading hours during the upgrade. Access to businesses and shops will remain in place during the construction works. The public is encouraged to support local Kangaroo Island businesses during the project's construction phase.

ESTIMATED TIME OF WORKS

Weather permitting, the scheduled works on the north side of Dauncey Street should be complete before Easter.

PARKING

Parking will be restricted along the north side of Dauncey Street. Parking will be available on the southern side of the road. Please remember parking is also available at the back of Council, off Osmond Street.

PEDESTRIAN ACCESS

Pedestrian access to shop fronts on both sides of Dauncey Street will be maintained.

SPEED LIMITS

Please note the speed limit between Murray Street and Commercial Street has been reduced to 25 km per hour during construction.

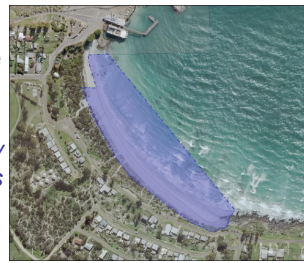
KANGAROO ISLAND COUNCIL DOGS BY-LAW 5

There have been 77 Ross River cases reported in the State so far this year, compared to 48 cases at the same time last year.
