TOWN CENTRES PROJECT UPDATE: 25 AUGUST TO 1 SEPTEMBER

AMERICAN RIVER

American River's upgrade is well and truly taking shape. The paved footpath is complete around the wharf precinct and along Tangara Drive, the mosaics have been reinstated and the cobblestone circular paving around the jetty timber posts is almost finished. The tree and shrub planting, stonework on the custom seats and completion of the garden edging will be taking place over the next week.

KINGSCOTE

Council would like to remind the community that Dauncey Street is not 100% complete and some concern around pooling water on the road is a result of the levels not being finalised. This will be resolved when the contractor returns to complete the outdoor dining area, complete the raised 'wombat' crossings at Commercial and Murray Streets, resurface and line mark the road. Some ongoing maintenance will continue until then to ensure the comfort and safety of users of Dauncey Street.

PENNESHAW UPGRADE

The new fence, seat and planting along the DIT-managed Bay Terrace is now complete. The last stage of the \$200k SATC improvements will be wayfinding signage to link the terminal and town centre. The upgrade provides a safer and more enjoyable pedestrian experience in time for the busier holiday and cruise ship visitor period.

Phase 1 of the Town Centres Project has been fully funded by the SA Government's Open Spaces and Places for People grant and the Commonwealth Government's Drought Communities Program.
