Exceptional Circumstance Bin (EC)

EC bins are blue lidded and must have a registered Fleurieu Regional Waste Authority (FRWA) sticker on the front to be collected. The EC provisions aim to assist large families, households using nappies, or domestic medical waste and need to be renewed annually.

To be considered for an EC bin please download and complete the form found at kangarooisland.sa.gov.au/ services/forms and lodge at 43 Dauncey Street.

If you would like to renew your EC bin complete and submit the renewal form that you will receive by post or email.

Only EC bins with correct stickers will be collected from 1 July 2021.



Law requires dogs & cats to be microchipped & desexed

All dogs and cats over 12 weeks of age must be microchipped and the details must be entered on the statewide register, Dogs & Cats Online (DACO).

Dogs & Cats born after 1 July 2018 must be desexed by 6 months of age (exemptions apply).
