TOWN CENTRES PROJECT UPDATE: 23 to 30 JUNE



CONSTRUCTION WORKS

The remaining weeks in Kingscote will see the completion of the outdoor dining areas (existing and new), furniture installation, mortar along the building edges, irrigation, planting and fixing of remaining timber to bollards. There will be some planting installed along the Murray Street foreshore connection, Dauncey Street (between Murray and Drew Streets) and a path connecting the foreshore trail to Murray Street.

DAUNCEY STREET - SPEED LIMIT AND PARKING

The final road resurfacing and 2 raised 'wombat' crossings will be postponed until September 2022 to avoid two separate road closures. This is due to unsuitable weather conditions for bitumen work as a result of project delays. Advance notice will be provided prior to the anticipated road closure and Council will coordinate with the contractor to deliver the work over consecutive days to minimise the disruption to traders.

SATC FUNDING

From 27 June 2022, an upgrade and general tidy up of the footpath along Bay Terrace will be underway.

This work is being supported by a \$200,000 grant from the South Australian Tourism Commission to improve the safety and experience of pedestrians between the ferry terminal and town centre

Some speed reductions, pedestrian diversions and part lane closures will be in place along Bay Terrace but will not affect the loading and unloading of ferry traffic.
