2024 ROAD RESEAL PROGRAM

Kangaroo Island Council undertakes annual bitumen resealing work on our sealed road network to rejuvenate and extend the life of roads and streets.

The bitumen resealing process consists of spraying a thin film of bitumen across the road surface and then adding small stones on top of the bitumen film. This forms a durable waterproof layer on top of the road, can improve the skid resistance of the road surface, and reduces the occurrence of potholes and cracks.

Council will undertake our reseal program this year via our contactor from Thursday, 21 March, until Monday, 25 March 2024.

Please follow the traffic management while this work takes place and be aware that you may encounter delays.
