

TOWN CENTRES PROJECT UPDATE: 26 MAY TO 2 JUNE

CONSTRUCTION WORKS

Paving will continue along the southern side of Dauncey Street and drainage infrastructure is to be completed at the Ozone laneway. Demolition will continue up towards Commercial Street with rubble paths installed to ensure access to businesses remains open at all times. Benches using the Kingscote Jetty timber are being assembled at the Men's Shed and furniture and planting will be installed in the coming weeks.

DAUNCEY STREET - SPEED LIMIT AND PARKING

Parking continues to be affected during work hours on the southern side of Dauncey Street. Barriers and speed restrictions will remain in place, and parking is available at the back of Council off Osmond Street.

NATIVE SHELLFISH RESTORATION PROJECT

The Nature Conservancy Australia (TNC) is holding community information sessions on Tuesday 31 May 2022 to share details of the native shellfish reef restoration project taking place on KI in 2022.

Learn about native oyster reefs, the benefits they bring to local communities and how similar projects in SA are tracking.

To find out how the reefs will be constructed and what they hope to achieve for the environment, residents and visitors to Kangaroo Island, come to the community information session on:

SATC FUNDING FOR PENNESHAW

Council is in the final stages of negotiation with a local contractor to undertake some footpath and kerb replacement work, new furniture, planting installation and general tidy up along Bay Terrace as part of a \$200,000 grant by the South Australian Tourism Commission (SATC) to improve the safety and experience of pedestrians between the ferry terminal and town centre.

This work will complement the upcoming Town Centres Project in Middle Terrace due to be completed in Spring 2022, and some furniture replacement on the North Tce lawn area to be completed by June 30, 2022. Further details of work schedules and any traffic impacts will be provided as they become available.



TIDAL POOL UPGRADES

As part of Council's 2021/2022 Capital Works Program, a new safer and compliant staircase has been constructed at the Tidal Pool, and in the coming weeks a new BBQ shelter will be completed.

This is an example of Council working towards achieving outcomes of its Disability Access & Inclusion Plan and will be supported by the installation of Mobi-Mat® beach access matting during summer. The funding for the access mats is being supported by The Harcourts Foundation and Community Living Australia.
