TOWN CENTRES PROJECT UPDATE: 9 to 16 JUNE



CONSTRUCTION WORKS

The final section of paving will be completed on the South East side towards Commercial Street as well as the outdoor area dining area. Remaining timber will continue to be fixed to bollards working down from Murray Street, as well as preparation for planting, irrigation and furniture installation. The Telstra contractors have completed their pit level adjustments and these sections of paving and remaining drainage will be adjusted over the next fortnight.

DAUNCEY STREET - SPEED LIMIT AND PARKING

The final road level adjustments, resurfacing and 2 raised 'wombat' crossings will be postponed until September 2022 to avoid two separate road closures. This is due to unsuitable weather conditions for bitumen work as a result of project delays. Parking will be uninterrupted, but the current road surface and speed reductions will remain in place in the meantime. Advance notice will be provided and Council will coordinate with the contractor to deliver the work over consecutive days to minimise the disruption to traders.


