PREVENT MOZZIES FROM BREEDING!

Check Rainwater tanks for gaps, check that inlet and overflow pipes are covered with insect screens.

All rainwater tank openings after 2005 must be fitted with mesh no larger than 1mm.

The only method to remove mozzies from rainwater tanks is to add chemicals. However chemicals contaminate the rainwater. The best thing you can do is seal your tank to protect your water source and prevent breeding

Other breeding sites that should be checked are:

- Tyres
- Swimming pools
- Garbage bins & recycling bins
- Clogged gutters & runoff
- Swing sets and toys
- Oil drums & buckets
- Novelties & ornaments
- Boats & kayaks



RAA REGIONAL SAFETY GRANT APPLICATIONS NOW OPEN

How much funding can you apply for?

Who can apply for funding?

Groups that are eligible to apply for funding must be regional* and include:

- not-for-profit organisations
- schools
- community groups

ACTIVE CLUB PROGRAM

The Active Club Program provides funding to support active recreation and sport clubs to further develop the programs and services they provide with in the South Australian community.

For eligible applicants with less than 100 members the maximum grant available will be \$1,500 and for applicants with 100 or more members the maximum grant available will be \$3,000.

This program is to support the achievement of:

- Affordable sport and recreation opportunities: reducing costs associated with participating in sport and recreation
- Sustainable sport and recreation sector: reducing costs associated with delivering sport and recreation
- More and better trained volunteers: supporting, recruiting, training and/or retaining volunteers.

SA AWARD FOR COMMUNITY IMPACT

The Asia-Pacific Spatial Excellence Awards are conducted regionally across the Asia Pacific. The South Australian awards night was held on the 17th of September. Tonkin won the APSE Award for Community Impact as a result of their Kangaroo Island Fire Damage Assessment 2020 work.

Kangaroo Island Council needed to assess the fire damage to assets and infrastructure to apply for funding through a Local Government Disaster Recovery Assistance Arrangement.

Tonkin provided a GIS-based solution to conduct condition assessments of damaged assets under challenging conditions and assist Council with the disaster recovery funding process.

The initiative has played a vital role in Kangaroo Island's economic, environmental and community recovery. The judges commended the practical use of spatial technologies to support the council and community.
