TOWN CENTRES UPDATE

Penneshaw: Request For Quotation - Limestone retaining wall construction

Kangaroo Island Council is seeking quotations from LOCAL stonemasons to construct a limestone retaining wall in Middle Terrace, Penneshaw, as part of the Town Centres Project.

About the wall:

- 75m total length (refer to photos attached for location)
- Height typically 750mm tapering to 300mm at both ends
- Adjacent to new clay paved footpath (footpath can be closed while work is being undertaken, but the site must be left safe when not on the worksite). Footpath to be protected by ply sheets or similar to limit damage to new pavers.
- Brighton lime mortar (or similar equivalent) to be used, with a 1m sample to be provided and approved by the Council prior to completing the remainder of the wall
- The existing permapine retaining wall has already been removed and the slope has been excavated ready for installation
- Limestone already located on site can be used if deemed suitable, the contractor is responsible for supplying the limestone. It is expected that the stone will be sourced from the island



Proposed wall location: existing conditions

Methodologies

Two stonewall methodologies will be considered by Council. Contractors can price either one or both types:

Wall Type A:

Dry stacked limestone wall with mortared cap and suitable layback, small stones to conceal gaps fixed with mortar (base preparation has been completed by another contractor), drainage behind and backfilling, with AGI pipe and geofabric.

Wall Type B:

Concrete block wall with limestone facing, concrete footing, damp proof membrane, backfill with drainage, mortared joints not to exceed ~20mm.



Contractor prerequisites include:

- \$20m public liability insurance
- ABN registration
- Willingness to comply with Council's safe work practices and standards
- Demonstration of examples of other stonework (preferably on Kangaroo
- Availability to commence in early 2023
