TOWN CENTRES PROJECT UPDATE



The Parndana Town Square upgrade will start in the first week of April. This work is estimated to take four to five weeks and includes paving, planting, pergola construction and furniture installation. Disruption to businesses and pedestrians is expected to be minimal but the project team will provide updates as the work progresses.

A local contractor will complete the Penneshaw limestone retaining wall over the coming weeks. With Penneshaw, American River and Kingscote now practically complete, Axiom Projects will continue with the defects across the three townships next week.
