Important Information for Year Ending 30th June 2024

Capital Value

Capital value is defined under section 5 of the *Valuation of Land Act* 1971. The Capital Value of land is the capital amount that might reasonably be expected to be obtained upon sale of the land on an unencumbered basis.

Payment of Rates

Rates are payable in four quarterly instalments. You may elect to pay any instalment in advance. We will send you further notices for each quarter. If the amount due remains unpaid after the due date, the arrears along with any accrued penalties may be recovered using Council's debt recovery process.

Fines on Rates

Rates will be overdue if they have not been paid by the "Last Day to Pay" shown on the front of this notice. After this date, the following additional charges (as per the *Local Government Act 1999*) will apply:-

- a fine of 2% of the amount due will be immediately added to the amount due: and
- each month thereafter, interest (at the rate prescribed in the Local Government Act 1999) will be added on any balance (including interest) not then paid.

Postponement of Rates for State Seniors

Ratepayers who hold a State Seniors Card (or who are eligible to hold a State Seniors Card and have applied for one) are able to apply to Council to postpone payment of rates on their <u>principal place of residence</u>. Postponed rates remain as a charge on the land and are not required to be repaid until the property is sold or disposed of (subject to Council's conditions). Regional Landscape Levy

The Regional Landscape Levy is a State tax. Councils are required under the *Landscape South Australia Act 2019* to collect the Levy on all rateable properties on behalf of the State Government... Objection to Valuation

You may object to the valuation referred to in this notice by writing served personally or by post on the Valuer-General within 60 days after the date of service of this notice.

BUT NOTE:

- if you have previously received a notice or notices under the Local Government Act 1999 referring to the valuation and informing you of a 60-day objection period, the objection period is 60 days after service of the first such notice;
- b. you may not object to the valuation if the Valuer-General has already considered an objection by you to that valuation.

The Valuer-General may extend the 60-day objection period where it be shown there is reasonable cause to do so by a person entitled to make an objection to a valuation.

A written objection to valuation must set out the full and detailed grounds for objection including any supporting information.

Rates are still due and payable by the due date even if an objection to valuation has been lodged.

Objection to Land Use

Differential General Rates imposed by the Council are based on various Land Use categories. Should you have any reason to believe that the Land Use category applied to your account is incorrect, you may lodge a written objection with Council outlining the grounds upon which your objection is based. (Including the Land Use Category that you consider should have been attributed) Objections must be submitted to Council within 60 days of receiving the first quarter notice.

Rates are still due and payable by the due date, even if an objection has been lodged.

Voters Roll

Persons on the State House of Assembly Electoral Roll with their primary place of residence on Kangaroo Island are automatically included in the Council Voters Roll and entitled to vote in Council elections. Others who are ratepayers, may also be entitled to be enrolled on the Council Voters Roll but will need to apply for enrolment.
