

TOWN CENTRES PROJECT UPDATE: 2 to 9 JUNE



CONSTRUCTION WORKS

The final stage of demolition, drainage and installation of paving between the Ozone laneway and Commercial Street will be underway. Access to businesses will remain open at all times. Benches using the Kingscote Jetty timber are being assembled at the Kingscote Men's Shed with the furniture, irrigation and planting to be installed.

DAUNCEY STREET - SPEED LIMIT AND PARKING

Parking continues to be restricted in some sections on the southern side of Dauncey Street. Barriers and speed restrictions will remain in place, and parking is available at the back of Council off Osmond Street.

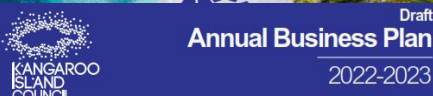
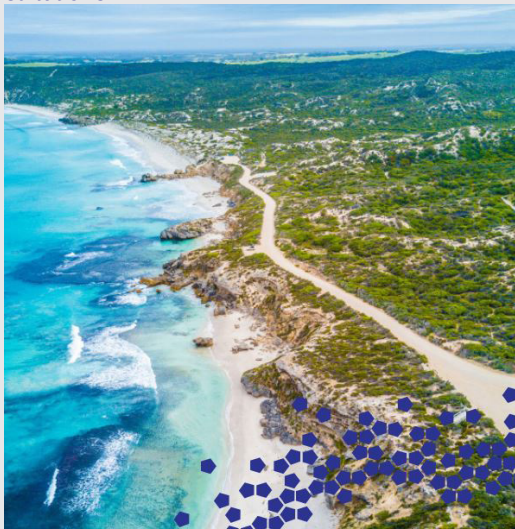

SATC FUNDING FOR PENNESHAW
