PUBLIC CONSULTATION INFRASTRUCTURE & ASSET MANAGEMENT PLANS

Council's Infrastructure and Asset Management Plan (IAMP) details information about Kangaroo Island Council's infrastructure assets with actions required to provide an agreed level of service in the most cost-effect manner while outlining associated risks. The plan defines the services to be provided, how the services are provided and what funds are required over a 10 year planning period with consideration given to the following 10 years.

The IAMP is considered a strategic management plan and feeds into the long-term financial plan and the annual business plan. It consists of eight (8) chapters: an introduction and a chapter for each asset class.

Council is seeking feedback on the IAMP, in particular the levels of service (section 3 of each chapter) as these help guide the maintenance levels and the priority of renewal and upgrade of assets.
