TOWN CENTRES PROJECT UPDATE: 28 JULY TO 4 AUGUST

KANGAROO ISLAND

KINGSCOTE

Last week saw the completion of Kingscote's planting, furniture and miscellaneous items. Council is working with a local supplier to complete the steel support for the bollards, and the remaining red gum will then be fixed. The final road resurfacing and 2 raised 'wombat' crossings have been postponed until September 2022 when the conditions improve for bitumen, and residents will be advised of an unavoidable road closure.

AMERICAN RIVER

The site setout and paving preparation is underway along the foreshore path. Reduced speed limits and some restricted parking and pedestrian access can be expected over the coming weeks. Council will continue to liaise with residents and businesses around the wharf precinct as the work advances, but minimal impact on traffic and access is anticipated.

PENNESHAW UPGRADE

The installation of furniture, signage, native planting, mulch and a new fence will complete the Bay Terrace footpath upgrade. Some speed reductions and part lane closures remain in place along the DIT-controlled Bay Terrace but do not affect ferry traffic. Residents are reminded to ensure their domestic pets are secured for the safety of the Little Penguin population. Residents may also have noticed the new picnic settings on the North Terrace lawns.

Got something to say? Enrol to vote today! Would you like to make a difference to your community? Have you considered nominating to be a Council Member and making decisions in the best interests of the Kangaroo Island community?

The next Council election will take place in November 2022. Unlike State and Federal elections, it is not compulsory to vote in South Australian council elections and all voting is done by post.

Enrolled voters receive a voting package through the mail and return their votes in a reply paid envelope. If you already registered on the State Electoral Roll as a resident on Kangaroo Island, you will automatically be sent a voting package through the mail.

People who are not on the State Electoral Roll wishing to vote in the Council Election must submit a written enrolment form within a Council Election year, before 29 July 2022.

People who wish to nominate for Council as an Elected Member must be enrolled to vote by Friday 29 July 2022.
