PUBLIC CONSULTATION – INFRASTRUCTURE & ASSET MANAGEMENT PLANS

Council's Infrastructure and Asset Management Plan (IAMP) details information about Kangaroo Island Council's infrastructure assets with actions required to provide an agreed level of service in the most cost-effect manner while outlining associated risks. The plan defines the services to be provided, how the services are provided and what funds are required over a 10 year planning period with consideration given to the following 10 years.

The IAMP is considered a strategic management plan and feeds into the long-term financial plan and the annual business plan. It consists of eight (8) chapters: an introduction and a chapter for each asset class.

Council is seeking feedback on the IAMP, in particular the levels of service (section 3 of each chapter) as these help quide the maintenance levels and the priority of renewal and upgrade of assets.

BUSHFIRE PREVENTION AND AWARENESS

Visitors to Kangaroo Island, please be aware that we are now in Fire Danger Season until Tuesday, 30 April 2024.

This summer, Council is urging all residents and visitors to the Island to be proactive, make sure they know when the CFS declares a Total Fire Ban Day and adhere to the restrictions that may prevent bushfires - and to have a Bushfire Action Plan.

Understanding what to do and how to act during Fire Danger Season could save your life. How do I know when a total fire ban is declared?

The Fire Danger Rating system has changed. It's now simpler with clear actions to take.

There are now four levels of Fire Danger Ratings:

During Fire Danger Season, the CFS declare the fire rating at 4.30 pm every day for the following day.

On days when Extreme and Catastrophic ratings for Kangaroo Island are declared, Total Fire Bans are imposed, and restrictions apply.

We are asking everyone to be proactive and check the rating every day.
