FUEL LOAD REDUCTION

Council would like to remind landholders that now is the best time, in these final months before summer, to start planning and carrying out fuel reduction activities when the risks of fire and interaction with native fauna (such as snakes) are lower.

FIGHT THE BITE: MOZZIE PROTECTION

Have you noticed the abundance of mosquitoes hanging around already this year? We have put together some handy tips to help you evade the nasty pests coming into the warmer months.



- Cover-Up:** Loose comfortable clothing (long sleeves & trousers)
- Apply Repellent** – containing DEET (diethyltoluamide) or picaridin
- Clean Up** – Don't provide breeding sites. Remove items that can hold water. This includes poorly maintained rainwater tanks and gutters.
