KINGSCOTE

The next week will see the outstanding items for Dauncey Street finalised, including the outdoor dining area and mortar at building edges on the South Eastern side, mulch in the garden beds, boulders in the garden beds and benches from the Kingscote Jetty installed. The remaining trees on Murray Street and foreshore planting and kerb ramp will also be installed.

2022 COUNCIL ELECTIONS

Got something to say? Enrol to vote today!

Would you like to make a difference to your community? Have you considered nominating to be a Council Member and making decisions in the best interests of the Kangaroo Island community?

The next Council election will take place in November 2022. Unlike State and Federal elections, it is not compulsory to vote in South Australian council elections and all voting is done by post.

Enrolled voters receive a voting package through the mail and return their votes in a reply paid envelope. If you already registered on the State Electoral Roll as a resident on Kangaroo Island, you will automatically be sent a voting package through the mail.

People who are not on the State Electoral Roll wishing to vote in the Council Election must submit a written enrolment form within a Council Election year, before **29 July 2022**.

People who wish to nominate for Council as an Elected Member must be enrolled to vote by **Friday 29 July 2022**.

BAY TERRACE, PENNESHAW UPGRADE

Work has begun on a footpath and general tidy up of Bay Terrace. A new kerb, pram ramp will be in place for the paving to commence, with the contractors working their way up towards Middle Terrace over the coming weeks.

This work is being supported by a \$200,000 grant from the South Australian Tourism Commission to improve the safety and experience of pedestrians between the ferry terminal and town centre.

Some speed reductions, pedestrian diversions and part lane closures will be in place along Bay Terrace but will not affect the loading and unloading of ferry traffic.
