

## TOWN CENTRES PROJECT UPDATE: 14 to 21 JULY

### CONSTRUCTION WORKS: KINGSCOTE & AMERICAN RIVER

The next week will see demolition and setout of the American River project continue, while some final touches of Dauncey Street are completed. Council is awaiting the final steel for the bollard support to be welded and the remaining timber can be fixed. The road resurfacing and 2 wombat crossings will be postponed until September 2022 due to the cooler weather unsuitable for asphalt. A 25kph speed limit will remain in place until then. Advance notice will be provided prior to the anticipated road closure.

### BAY TERRACE, PENNESHAW UPGRADE

The paving and kerbing has been completed for the new footpath and general tidy up of Bay Terrace. A seat halfway up the hill, slope stabilisation as well as a new fence and planting will be installed over the coming weeks. Some speed reductions and part lane closures will be in place along but will not affect the loading and unloading of ferry traffic. The revegetation of the slope to protect the Penneshaw penguin population is of utmost priority and residents are reminded to ensure their domestic pets are secured for the safety of the penguins.

### PENNESHAW FURNITURE INSTALLATION

The three picnic settings have had their slabs poured on North Tce, and in the coming week the new picnic settings will be installed to complement the 2 recliners. The supply and installation of this furniture is being funded by the Town Centres Project and Council's 2021/22 Capital Program.

### LONG VEHICLE (TRUCK) PARKING REGULATIONS

Australian Road Rules are clear in regard to parking for long or heavy vehicles in residential streets and arterial roads.

Under the Australian Road Rules, a long or heavy vehicle may not be stopped or parked on a road (including the shoulder of the road or verge) for more than one hour unless the vehicle is dropping off or picking up goods. If dropping off or picking up goods for a period longer than one hour, must be actively unloading or loading.

Parking a long or heavy vehicle on a road for more than an hour is an offence and the driver may incur an expiation notice, plus further notices for each hour the vehicle remains parked.

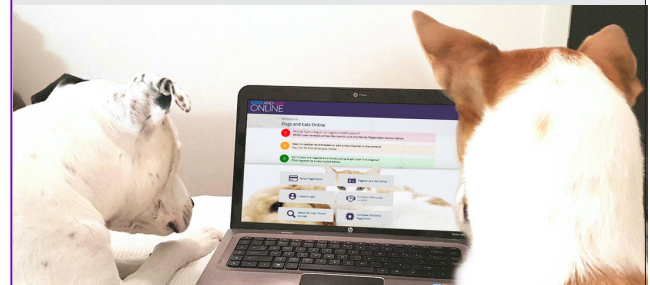
### ANIMAL REGISTRATIONS NOW DUE
