

TOWN CENTRES PROJECT UPDATE: 4 TO 11 AUGUST



AMERICAN RIVER

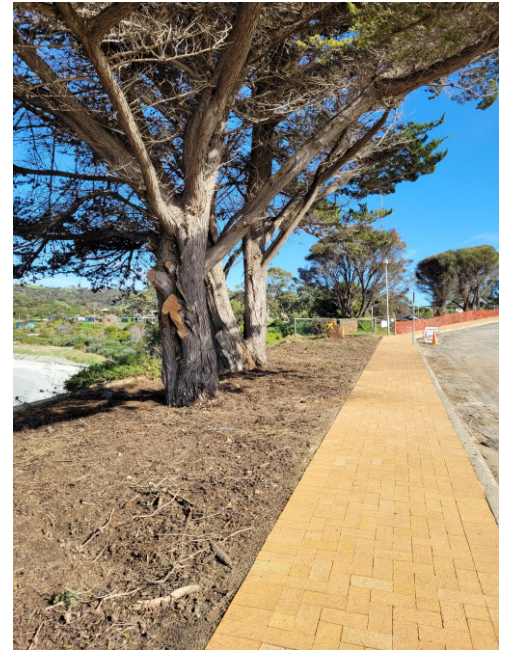
Construction is underway on the eastern side of Tangara Drive and around the wharf. Reduced speed limits and some restricted parking and pedestrian access can be expected, with minimal disruption to businesses. Paving and the garden bed edging will commence from next week (weather permitting), with supplementary coastal species to be planted concurrently.

KINGSCOTE

Council is awaiting steel from a local supplier to complete the bollards on the North Western side of Dauncey Street. Council is also working with relevant parties to complete the outdoor dining area on the South Eastern side of Dauncey Street. As previously advised, a road closure to resurface the road and complete the raised 'wombat' crossings is expected to be completed in September 2022 when the conditions improve for bitumen.

PENNESHAW UPGRADE

Last week saw a tidy up of the pine trees and understorey invasive plantings, installation of the slope stabilisation matting and saltbush cuttings near the Penguin Centre. The new fence will be completed in the coming weeks once the panels are completed by a local fabricator. Council will be working with a local landscaper this week to install some native coastal plantings along the new footpath, and the Nat Thomas St - North Tce and Bay Tce - Middle Tce intersections. The last stage of the \$200k SATC improvements will be wayfinding signage to link the terminal and town centre. Residents are reminded to ensure their domestic pets are secured for the safety of the Penneshaw Little Penguin population while the temporary fencing is in place.

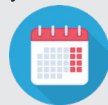

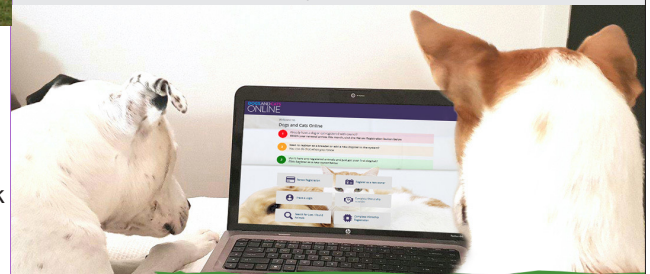
ANIMAL REGISTRATIONS NOW DUE
