The IAMP is considered a strategic management plan and feeds into the long-term financial plan and the annual business plan. It consists of eight (8) chapters: an introduction and a chapter for each asset class.

Council is seeking feedback on the IAMP, in particular the levels of service (section 3 of each chapter) as this helps guide the maintenance levels and the priority of renewal and upgrade of assets.

The Guidelines for the Management of Roadside Native Vegetation and Regrowth Vegetation were prepared to provide parameters for local councils and the SA Department for Infrastructure and Transport to manage native vegetation in road reserves to maintain the safety and visibility of roadsides while retaining important native vegetation values.
