## TREE ASSESSMENT AND REMOVAL

Staff, together with licenced arborists, have completed Arboriculture Vegetation Risk Assessments of trees in both Kingscote and Parndana. As a result a number of trees have been identified as hazardous, and will be removed in the near future. These trees include:

- 1 Sheoak on Anzac Street, Kingscote
- 1 Eucalyptus in Wright Park, Kingscote (first step is to significantly trim this tree, it may not need to be removed)
- 2 Southern Blue Gums on Jones Street, Parndana
- 1 Flowering Gum on Grenfell Street, Kingscote

Progress Associations have been advised of these works, which are planned to commence over the coming month. Once removed, suitable replacements will be planted. For images of trees to be removed please visit Council's website.
