Eligibility

1. Nominees for Citizen of the Year must be an Australian citizen.
2. Nominees for all Awards must be Kangaroo Island residents or rate payers of Kangaroo Island Council.
3. Members of Council and staff are not eligible to receive Awards for achievement in association with their elected member or employment responsibilities. However, other achievements by Elected Members or staff (eg sporting, business pursuit) can be recognized in the same way as any other member of the community.
4. All entries must include an image of the person/event/project as a JPEG. If people appear in photos their names should be supplied and it will be understood that they have given consent for the photo to be used by Kangaroo Island Council at any time for the purpose of promoting Kangaroo Island Council Awards.
5. Incomplete nominations may be deemed ineligible.
