PUBLIC CONSULTATION PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURE - CAPE WILLOUGHBY ROAD, CAPE WILLOUGHBY

Prior to considering a road process as per Section 5 of the Roads (Opening and Closing) Act 1991 to close the portion of the Cape Willoughby Road road-reserve adjacent to Cape Willoughby Conservation Park at Cape Willoughby.
