The entry fee is a gold coin donation for all spectators.

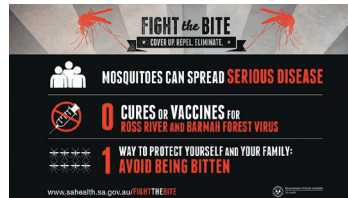
A barbeque lunch is available on the day for purchase, along with chips, chocolates, soft drinks and alcoholic beverages.

## PUBLIC HEALTH NOTICE



We all know mosquitoes can be a nuisance, but some can spread serious diseases when they bite.

**How to protect yourself and your family from mosquito bites**

SA Health advises the following:

- **Cover up** - Wear long, loose-fitting, light-coloured clothing.
- **Repel** - Use a mosquito repellent containing either DEET, Picaridin, or Oil of Lemon Eucalyptus (PMD) that have been approved by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA).
- **Eliminate** - Stop mosquitoes breeding in water pooling around your property.

## NEW LEGISLATION



**SMOKE-FREE  
AND  
VAPE-FREE  
AREA**

From 1 March 2024, new laws were introduced by the State Government to prohibit smoking and vaping in a variety of public outdoor areas in South Australia.

Regulations under the South Australian Tobacco and E-Cigarette Products Act 1997 were introduced to address risks associated with passive tobacco smoking and passive inhalation of e-cigarette aerosol.

This will occur through the creation of smoke-free and vape-free areas in the following areas:

- Within 10m of a childcare facility or school,
- Within 10m of any non-residential buildings, such as shops, the library, and restaurants
- Within 10m of the Kangaroo Island Health Service, hospital and aged care facilities
- Within 10m of the Kingscote tidal pool
- Within 10m of a sporting venue during an underage sporting event, training or practice session
- On any jetty
