ADVANCE BURN NOTICES

Landholders have begun applying for burn off permits through CFS and Council. Please don't be alarmed if you smell or see smoke periodically from now until May 2021. The burn off fires are to reduce vegetation or stubble for farming, and will be controlled and attended. www.cfs.sa.gov.au/warnings-and-incidents

ROAD MAINTENANCE

Council is currently undertaking a drainage maintenance program as we enter the transition from summer to winter. Much time is being invested in clearing drains whilst they're still accessible before the onset of wet weather.

With the dry summer conditions, our road network is deteriorating at a fast rate which is normal for this time of year. To manage this, Council is currently prioritising the grading of roads and areas that generally experience higher traffic loads.

SOUTH COAST ROAD SEALING

While the current stage of Hickmans Road is being sealed, works are already underway in preparation for the final sector to South Coast Road. Core sampling of the existing road south of East West Highway 2 has been undertaken by Southern Geo. This testing will support a pavement design to cater for increased traffic volume and type. Different traffic ratios are expected due to the newly sealed route.

FENCING WIRE COLLECTION

Green Industries SA (GISA) have committed further funding to a final clean-up of bushfire affected fencing wire. This follows a prior clean up earlier in the recovery phase. In this project, landowners who have gathered burnt fence wire rolls will be able to register to have it collected and disposed of.

Council will be managing the project on behalf of GISA, and tenders have been called for local and other contractors to submit their rates for consideration.

It is expected that registrations will be finalised in early April from landowners - many of whom may already be registered on a list held by the recovery centre at Parndana. The rolls of wire will be required to be clean (no fence posts or spacers attached) and stored in significant heaps on the property close to the nearest roadway.

Works to collect the clean fence wire and ship to the KI Resource Recovery Centre will commence in April and is expected to take up to 5 weeks.
