#### **SHOULDER SEALING - PLAYFORD HWY**

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is improving safety on the Playford Highway, between Birchmore Road and 1.4km west of Bark Hut Road.

The upgrade works include shoulder sealing, the replacement of guide posts and new line marking.

The works have commenced and are expected to be completed mid-2021, weather permitting.

The works will be undertaken between 7:00am and 5:30pm. Monday to Friday with the road remaining open to traffic. A 25km/h speed restriction is in place while workers are onsite and other traffic restrictions may apply, subject to onsite conditions.
