TOWN CENTRES PROJECT UPDATE: 11 TO 18 AUGUST

AMERICAN RIVER

American River's first town centre footpath is being paved along Tangara Drive and around the wharf precinct, with the garden edging, furniture and planting to follow in the next week. Some coastal revegetation will continue to be installed along the foreshore, and residents are asked to stick to the paths to allow the locally sourced tube stock to establish.

KINGSCOTE

Council is awaiting steel from a local supplier to complete the bollards on the NW side of Dauncev Street. The contractor will return in Spring 2022 to complete the outdoor dining area, resurface the road and complete the raised 'wombat' crossings when the weather is suitable and to save costs by completing the Penneshaw bitumen work at the same time.

PENNESHAW UPGRADE

The new steel and timber fence is underway and a new seat in place. Council is also working with a local landscaper to install native coastal plantings along the new footpath, and nearby intersections. The last stage of the \$200k SATC improvements will be wayfinding signage to link the terminal and town centre. The removal of invasive and overgrown vegetation now offers pedestrians expansive views from the widened footpath to Hog Bay and the wildlife below.







Phase 1 of the Town Centres Project has been fully funded by the SA Government's Open Spaces and Places for People grant and the Commonwealth Government's **Drought Communities Program.**
