Administration have been investigating options for the Council owned Standpipes on Kangaroo Island. This review was presented to Elected Members at the 9th of May 2023 Council meeting, where the following resolution was made:

12.2 Kangaroo Island Council Standpipes

Council resolves to close the standpipes to third party users and keep them open for Council use.

We therefore wish to advise there will not be an option to renew access to Council Standpipes from 1st of July 2023.

Council considered the risk of continuing to offer this honesty system into the future. With usage declining, installing water filling stations was not a viable option, so the decision to close the standpipes to third party users was made.

Standpipe keys can be returned to Kingscote Council at the Customer Service Desk.

Should users continue to require access to water in the future, you have the option to source water from a commercial water carrier or contact SA Water to discuss options for a metered hydrant.
