Vietnam Veterans' Day on the 18th of August 2023 recognises the invaluable contribution of Australians who served in the Vietnam War.

Australia's involvement in the war formally ended in 1973, making this – the 50th anniversary – a particularly important year to commemorate.

More than 60,000 Australians served in Vietnam from 1962 to 1973, with some returning for humanitarian operations in 1975.

Sadly, 523 died, some 3,000 were wounded, and amidst strong anti-war sentiment many who returned home were treated unfairly by some members of the community.
