## COMMUNITY CONSULTATION

### STREET TREE PROGRAM 2023-2027

Council has committed to a 5-year plan and budget for street tree planting in the four main townships of Kingscote, Penneshaw, American River and Parndana.

Residents are invited to learn more about street trees and provide feedback on the proposed locations and preliminary species selection as part of the annual program.

**Consultation period is 28 days from Friday the 11th of August until 5:00pm Friday the 8th of September 2023.**

## RATES

In a progressive move towards enhancing service efficiency, Kangaroo Island Council has introduced an advanced approach to rate notice delivery.

On August 8th, Council declared rates for 2023/2024 and initiated the distribution of the first instalment of rate notices via email and postal addresses, marking a pivotal shift towards digital communication - while maintaining hard copies for ratepayers who choose to receive their communications by post.

Kangaroo Island Council has modernized its rate notice system, allowing property owners exclusive access to their notices through their EzyBill accounts. To benefit from this streamlined service, property owners simply need to register their EzyBill account by following the link provided:

Temporary speed limits will be in place and some roadworks may still be undertaken.

The bitumen spray seal will be completed when the warmer weather permits.

## PROJECT UPDATE

### BAUDIN BEACH BOAT RAMP

Council is working with the Baudin Beach Progress Association to upgrade the boat ramp at Baudin Beach.

We are excited to share the latest developments in the project.

The contractor has built the precast concrete slabs which are ready for installation. These slabs are currently onsite.

Works will recommence later in the year when the winds and tides are more favourable for construction.

Works are expected to take approximately one month, dependent on weather conditions.



Please be advised that the ramp will be closed to the public while the construction works take place.
