NEW PLANT ARRIVAL

The first of two newly purchased graders arrived on the Island last Thursday.

Council has again purchased John Deere 670GP graders which have a proven track record on the Island, replacing the ones purchased back in 2008.

The supplier of the machine was on Island in Council's Kingscote Depot to induct our Grader Operators with the latest technology of the new machine, before it was put to work.



These graders are a welcome upgrade to the fleet for road construction and patrol grading of rural roads on Kangaroo Island. This critical plant is vital to the efficient and effective ongoing maintenance of the unsealed road network on the Island.

The second grader is currently in Wingfield, SA, being assembled following arrival from the USA last week via shipping container.
