## Exceptional Circumstance Bins (EC)

### What is an Exceptional Circumstance Bin?

Residents can apply to Council and, if the criteria are met, may be eligible for an additional waste bin for fortnightly roadside collection.

These bins are blue lidded and must have a registered Fleurieu Regional Waste Authority (FRWA) sticker on the front to be collected.

The bins are attached to the applicant even if they move house and remain on loan from KI Council for the duration of being eligible.

The EC provisions aim to assist large families, households using nappies, or domestic medical waste and need to be renewed annually.

If you would like to renew your EC bin (before 11 June 2021) complete and submit the renewal form that you will receive by post or email.

Only EC bins with correct stickers will be collected from 1 July 2021.
