FENCING WIRE COLLECTION

Green Industries SA (GISA) have committed further funding to a final clean-up of bushfire affected fencing wire. In this project, landowners who have gathered burnt fence wire rolls will be able to register to have it collected and disposed of.

Landowners can register to have fence wire collected by contacting Council via email on kicouncil@kicouncil. sa.gov.au by Thursday 1st April.

The rolls of wire will be required to be clean (no fence posts or spacers attached) and stored in significant heaps on the property close to the nearest roadway.

CUSTOMER SERVICE REOUESTS

To date Council has received over 450 customer service requests since January this year. Approximately half of these have been assigned to the Asset Service Operational Team for action. Types of requests that have been attended to are:

- Road grading requests
- Footpath repairs
- Sign replacement and new installation
- Vegetation clearance
- Marina/Boat ramp repairs and maintenance
- Stormwater maintenance and repairs
- Pest control

Council officers have attended to many emergency phone calls including trees blocking roads and facility/ amenity maintenance many of which have required out of hours work.

The Operations Team is working hard to attend to requests in a timely manner whilst still keeping our major capital works program on track, including the resealing program, resheeting unsealed roads and the Hickmans Road sealed road upgrade.

ROADWORK NOTIFICATIONS

Council are currently undertaking sealing works on South Coast Road between Timber Creek and Birchmore Road. Please be aware of speed restrictions whilst works are in progress.

In addition to this, during the month of March, other sealing projects will be conducted on the following Roads

- Birchmore Road: North and South of Starrs Road - Seal Bay Road from South Coast Road to Seal Bay

Sealing works on Hickmans Road are now complete and the road has re-opened. Speed restrictions are in place whilst the new seal beds in. Please adhere to posted speed restrictions which will be in place for the next few weeks.
