RECYCLE BATTERIES AT KI COUNCIL OR KIRRC

Batteries are powerhouses that pack a punch. Even at end-of-life, batteries contain valuable resources that can be recycled an indefinite number of times.

This is why batteries should be recycled through the battery bin services, provided free of charge at:

- · Kangaroo Island Council offices
- Kangaroo Island Resource Recovery Centre (KIRRC on North Coast Road)

Batteries have a Jekyll and Hyde existence, the valuable resources they contain (lead, cadmium, mercury - to name a few) are also toxic and can poison people and pollute the environment - such as harming animals to contaminating soils and water when they are disposed to landfill.

Batteries can catch fire if they are damaged or overheated. Fleurieu Regional Waste Authority (FRWA) does NOT want them in any kerbside bin or in the Waste Collection Trucks.
