### NOTICE OF ROAD CLOSURE - ANZAC DAY

Section 33 Road Traffic Act 1961

Notice is hereby given that the Kangaroo Island Council make the following order:

That the Council exercises the power pursuant to Section 33(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1961 and Clause F of the Instrument of General Approval of the Minister dated 22 August 2013 to:

1. Pursuant to Section 33(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1961, declare that the events described below ("the Event") that is to take place on the roads described below ("the Roads") is an event to which Section 33 of the Road Traffic Act 1961 applies;
