

TOWN CENTRES PROJECT UPDATE: 19 TO 26 MAY

CONSTRUCTION WORKS

Formwork for the concrete protuberances and kerbs are being poured and the ACO drains will be installed up to the Ozone laneway. Footpaths will be demolished and prepared with a temporary rubble and access to businesses on the southern side to remain open at all times. Paving preparation will commence from the Murray Street end and timber will be fixed to the stainless steel bollard frames.

DAUNCEY STREET - SPEED LIMIT AND PARKING

As demolition work on the southern side has commenced, parking on that side will be impacted over the coming weeks. Parking is available at the back of Council off Osmond Street. The speed limit between Murray Street and Commercial Street has been reduced to 25km per hour as construction continues.
