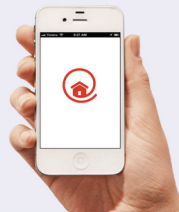


MY LOCAL SERVICES APP - WASTE COLLECTION DETAILS

My Local services App will display the correct information for fortnightly waste collection.

To ensure you have the up to date version of the My Local Services App, update it direct from the App store.

Alternatively, if you do not wish to do this, resetting your address in the settings screen should also update the waste collection data.



CAMPING & BOATING REMINDER

Council would like to remind residents and visitors that when using campgrounds and boat ramps, permits need to be displayed at all times. General Inspectors will be checking campgrounds and boat ramps regularly.

Permits can be obtained at all Council campgrounds and boat ramps either via electronic pay station or via the self-registration payment stations.



We would appreciate when using our campgrounds the following rules apply:

- Camp only in designated areas.
- Where possible, the use of liquid fuel or gas stoves is recommended.
- Chainsaws are prohibited.
- Generators are permitted only between the hours 7.00am to 10.00pm.
- All Council campgrounds are pet friendly. Pet owners should ensure their pets are restrained via a lead at all times.
- No fires on Total Fire Ban Days
- Campgrounds are closed on catastrophic fire danger days. In the event that a catastrophic day is declared, you will be required to proceed to a designated safer place as early as practically possible. Camping and support facilities will be available at Penneshaw Oval, Middle Tce, Penneshaw and War Memorial Park, Centenary Ave, Kingscote.
