The Kangaroo Island Council's new Community Grant Program is designed to support community groups and individuals with initiatives that are determined to benefit the Island and community.

Community Grants are payments made by the Council to support local initiatives that progress community outcomes and contribute to sport and recreation, local

culture, demonstrate community benefit, and assist in meeting the Council's strategic goals and objectives.

The program is to offer a maximum financial contribution of \$4,000 per application, noting that some applications may be for amounts well below this threshold.

All funds allocated would be expended and acquitted within the current financial year or within twelve months of acceptance of a grant under

COMMUNITY CONSULTATION - UNNAMED ROADS

Council is seeking suggestions on the naming of unnamed roads. These roads are not included in the Department of Infrastructure & Transport (DIT) Rack Plan and as such, cannot have Rural Road Numbers assigned.

The roads have come from community requests and Council identification of roads that are currently unnamed but are used to access one or more properties.

The address for these properties relates to the nearest named road and can result in the properties having the same number with an 'A', 'B' or 'C' etc after. This does not help with property identification in emergency situations. This process will result in a change in address for these properties: however, will more accurately identify the property.

The following roads have had requests for naming or have been identified by Council as requiring a name:

- 1. "Dashwood Track"
- 2. "Ritchie Road"
- 3. Road off D'Estrees Bay Road, D'Estrees Bay
- 4. Road off South Coast Road, Vivonne Bay
- 5. Road off Links Road. Brownlow
- 6. Road off Ratcliff Track. Pelican Lagoon
- 7. Road south of KI racecourse, **Cvanet River**
- 8. Road off Cape Willougby Road, Willoughby
- 9. Road off Hog Bay Road, Baudin Beach

These roads are proposed to be added to Council's asset register as either Non-Council roads or Unmade-Accessible roads.

They will not have a financial value and will not be included on the renewal schedule. If these roads are currently graded, they will be included in the grading program at a maximum frequency of once per year.

Local residents Deane (pictured above) and Janet Modra were the first to utilise the upgraded ramp that the community have been eagerly awaiting.


