Grants of up to \$10,000 are available for activities such as:- effective control of weeds, feral animals or over abundant native species, repairing damaged areas, internal property fencing, native animal survey.

Rates 2021/2022 – Snapshot

As part of the Annual Business Plan which is currently out for Community Consultation, there are some proposed changes to Rates:-

Rate capping removal – does not increase what Council collects but improves equity – you pay your share based on your capital value.

Fixed rate charge – after 10 years at the same charge, 2022 is proposed to go up \$50 to \$340.

Differential charges – primary production and vacant land differentials will go up (cents in the dollar).
